**Enrollment in and payment of your deposit for the tour, constitutes your acceptance of the conditions and statement of responsibility.**

**INCLUDED IN PRICE:** 1) Round trip airfare per brochure, deluxe motor coaches, First Class / Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast & dinner daily; 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$707 USD** comprised of **\$376.60** for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person); 3) Gratuities of **\$150** for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Not included in your package are passports, visas, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

**PAYMENT:** A full deposit of **\$500 per person is required at time of registration**. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (**credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form**), and is due no later than **90-days prior to departure**. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure **must be accompanied by full payment**. There may be a late fee of **\$195 for all payments or new registrations received 75-60 days prior to departure**. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 26 passengers for prices to be valid. If group size is 25-20 travelers, a \$150 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is 19-15 travelers, a \$195 per person supplement to price may apply. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by **Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC** (hereafter referred to as **Imagine**) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of **\$500 will be forfeited**. **Imagine** reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While **Imagine** will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a **single room supplement charge: \$575 for basic itinerary**. **ITINERARY and CHANGES:** Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, **Imagine** reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing to Imagine no later than 75-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. **All tours are final at 60-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.**

**LAND ONLY:** Land Only price is **\$2897 per person**. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** In order to keep prices low, **Imagine does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination**. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not **Imagine**. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once printed. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. **Imagine** is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers.

**VISAS:** Applicable visas will be obtained by **Imagine** for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. **Imagine** is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance

notice. **Imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays**. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. Passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**CANCELLATION FEES:** If the tour is cancelled due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees *plus any airline penalties if applicable*. Any cancellation from day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person *plus any airline penalties*, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 59 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-60 days = **\$500**; 59-45 days = **\$1750**; 44-25 days = **75% of total cost**; 24 days to day of departure = **100% of total cost**. **All Cancellations must be received in writing**. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. **We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance (please see the box below)**.

**PASSPORT:** Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip**. A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 90 days prior to departure.

This represents the entire agreement between the passenger and his agent, the travel agent, the tour host, and the tour operator. 

**DAY 1 - MONDAY, OCTOBER 31: DEPART U.S.A.**

Tour members depart the U.S.A. on our flight to Tel Aviv. After take-off, we will be served dinner according to the flight schedule.

**DAY 2 - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1: ARRIVE TEL AVIV, DEAD SEA**

We arrive at Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion airport in the afternoon. We are met by our tour representative and expert tour guide and driver. Our guide for these next nine days will provide us with invaluable help in gaining a deeper understanding of Israel's history, archaeology, culture, and modern life. We proceed southeast to Ein Bokek, a resort area along the Dead Sea, where you can finish your day with a float on the water. Our journey into the Scriptures has begun! Dinner and overnight are at the Dead Sea.

**DAY 3 - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 2: DEAD SEA, MASADA, EN GEDI, QUMRAN, GALILEE**

Heading forward in history today, we begin with Masada, Herod the Great's impressive mountain fortress where Jewish zealots made their last stand against their Roman conquerors in A.D. 73. Back to the Old Testament, we visit the oasis and springs of En Gedi, David's hiding place from Saul, and then onward. Then we head to Qumran, where Old Testament manuscripts dating to the second century were part of the famous Dead Sea Scrolls discovery. We'll see the caves where these scrolls were hidden by the Essenes for nearly 2,000 years. We'll then pass by Jericho (stopping if conditions permit) and travel up the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean. This city dates back to the Canaanites but is now known for its remarkable restored ruins from the days of the Decapolis in the Gospels. Our "long" day (both in terms of sightseeing and the length of the country) ends in Tiberias on the shores of the Sea of Galilee, where we have dinner and spend the night.

**DAY 4 - THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 3: GALILEE**

"Galilee" of the Gentiles comes alive today, as we head north to Tel Dan, the northernmost point in ancient Israel—one of the two places where Jeroboam erected a

calf for the northern tribes to worship. From this ancient city we make our way to Caesarea Philippi, a site of idol worship from Baal in the OT to the Greek god Pan during the NT times, and the place of Peter's great confession of Christ. We explore the Golan Heights, and have lunch in a Druze village (not included). Afterwards we visit Cana and have a wedding vows renewal in Cana, before returning to the shores of Galilee. Then we renew our Baptismal vows at the Jordan river. Dinner and overnight are in Tiberias.

**DAY 5 - FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4: GALILEE**

We continue to explore the Galilee today. We see a boat from Jesus' day and take a ride on the Sea of Galilee. Capernaum, the Mount of Beatitudes, the site of the multiplication of loaves and fish, Bethsaida—they all bear witness to the ministry of Jesus. We have St. Peter's fish for lunch (not included), and then head toward Nazareth, where we visit the Annunciation Church, the site where Angel Gabriel is believed to have appeared to Mary. Afterwards, we visit a recreation of a Nazareth village from the first century. We also visit Zippori, the major cultural center near Nazareth, and explore the possible links between this place and Jesus' early years. Dinner and overnight are in Tiberias.

**DAY 6 - SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5: MEGIDDO, CAESAREA MARITIMA, JERUSALEM**

We head to the center of the Holy Land today, beginning with our trip to Megiddo, the site of the fortified city of Solomon and Ahab and overlooking the Plain of

Jezeel-Armageddon. We then go to the Monastery of St. George, near the place where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal on Mt. Carmel. We then travel to the coast, where we visit Caesarea Maritima. This was the Roman capital and port for the province, and both Herod and Pilate lived here. It is also the place where the gospel came to the Roman centurion, Cornelius, opening the door of faith to Gentiles everywhere. We explore the ruins of Herod's day, a Crusader fortress, and see an aqueduct that brought water to the city. We then make our way to the true heart of the land—Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight are in Jerusalem.



**DAY 7 & 8 - SUNDAY & MONDAY, NOVEMBER 6 & 7: JERUSALEM & BETHLEHEM**

Jerusalem beckons and we will answer! Our activities will be governed by the times of availability of these sites, but we will experience this city fully. We'll visit the Mt. of Olives, upon which Jesus taught of the coming judgments, from which Jesus ascended, and where he will return to earth! We'll stop at the Pater Noster Church.

We'll make our way down the Palm Sunday Road, stopping in the Garden of Gethsemane. We'll visit the Southern Steps of the Temple, and we'll walk the traditional Via Dolorosa through the Old City as we pray the Way of the Cross. We keep walking to visit St. Anne's Crusader Church, the Stone Pavement under the Sisters of Zion Convent, ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the likely site of the crucifixion and burial of Jesus.

There will be a visit to the Western Wall—Judaism's holiest site, and to Temple Mount. Of great interest will be the Church of St. Peter Gallicantu—built over the site of the High Priest's home where Jesus was tried, and where Peter denied the Lord. We'll walk the streets and shop in the Old City, visiting trusted vendors for souvenirs. We'll make a trip to the City of David, seeing the excavations of David's palace and much more. We have the chance to go through Hezekiah's Tunnel—an ingenious water delivery system to the Pool of Siloam. Bring water shoes and be ready to get wet if you go. One evening, we'll walk through the Western Wall Tunnel and see the very foundations of that structure (conditions permitting). We will also make the trip to Bethlehem, where we'll see the Church of the Nativity. A visit to Bethlehem is completed by a stop at what we consider the very best olive wood store. Dinners and overnights are in Jerusalem.

**DAY 9 - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8: JERUSALEM**

Our last day in Jerusalem, we take a morning trip to see a scale model of the city from Jesus' time, and the Shrine of the Book, where parts of the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. We then go to Yad Vashem, the Israeli memorial for victims of the Holocaust. We return to our hotel for some free time. Afterwards we leave for a farewell dinner, and evening transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our late night flight home.

**DAY 10 - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9: ARRIVE BACK IN U.S.A.**

We arrive back to the U.S.A. today, with time to reflect on what we've seen and marvel at how much we have grown in our understanding of our faith.
