AWANA – Frequently Asked Questions

What is AWANA?	AWANA (Approved Workers Are Not Ashamed) is a Bible-centered childrens Ministry. AWANA is based on 2 nd Tim 2:15 – "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that need not be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. AWANA is committed to the evangelish and discipleship of our youth.
What makes AWANA different?	AWANA is based on 5 principles: 1. It is centered around the Gospels 2. Scripture study and memory are key elements 3. Youth are trained to serve Christ 4. It's built on volunteer leadership 5. It is exciting and fun
How is it structured?	The program involves 3 Awana Clubs. The members are called 'clubbers'. 1. Cubbies - Preschool 2. Sparks - Kindergarten to 2 nd Grade 3. T & T - 3 rd to 6 th Grade (Truth n Training)
How often does AWANA meet?	The AWANA clubs meet each week during Tuesday night Bible Study at the Fairfield campus (except 1st Tuesday in the month.) Parents can sign their children into AWANA before going to Bible Study
What are the requirement's to be a Worker	Have a desire to help develop Christ-centered children who are our future. Men and women are needed. It's about everyone doing a 'little bit' and following through on their commitment. There are many jobs to fill.
What are the requirment's to be a Clubber	Must be between preschool (3 yrs old) through 6 th grade. There is an annual fee for each clubber to cover the costs of their vest, workbook, and other supplies.
